The course catalog is used to give students an accurate list of courses to choose from when developing their academic plans. The catalog also allows advanced school-based functionality on the platform.

- All fields with a "Y" in the "Required" column must contain a valid value.
- All fields with an "N" in the "Required" column can be left blank.

| Subject | Y | Subject area for the course | Free Text | This is the subject area for the content of the course. This is not the CSU/UC A-G subject areaj. Usually this captures GraduationRequirements. | Physical Education |
| CourseTitle | Y | Transcript abbreviation | Free Text | Also known as the transcript abbreviation. Cannot be blank. | History 9 P |
| Description | Y | Long name of course | Free Text | Also known as the long title of the course. | Intro to Rock and Roll |
| CourseNumber | Y | | Alphanumeric | Also known as the Local Course ID. Cannot be blank. If unknown, then use "999999". | 1234A |
| Credits | Y | Credit Value | Numeric | Usually semester courses are 5 units and full year courses are 10 units. | 5 |
| Honors | Y | Advanced Coursework | Honors, AP, IB | Note that: blank = non-advanced course. | АР |



| Offered | Y | Active | Y, N | Indicates if the course is currently being offered. | Y = Active courseN = No longer offered |

| StateCourseCode | Y | CALPADS State Course Code | 4 digit # | This is the state course code and is used for CALPADS state reporting. <i>Please note that this</i> <i>is a different course code than</i> <i>the field</i> <i>CourseNumber above, which is</i> <i>a local identifier.</i> | 2670 |

To be CSV-Compliant

- File names must have the .csv extension.
- Files must be UTF-8 encoded with no byte order mark.
- Files must have a header row.
- Fields containing commas must be enclosed within double quotes.

File name format: {districtname}_CourseCatalog_yyyymmdd Example: SacramentoCity_CourseCatalog_20210901.csv
